### Marram, Montauk

Towards the wild eastern tip of Long Island, a former motel in Montauk has become flavour of the month among New Yorkers seeking to escape the frenetic pace of their 24-hour city. Marram sits on the Atlantic shoreline, looking out over sand dunes festooned with the wild marram grass from which it takes its name. The emphasis is firmly squared on slow living, with little to distract save the scenery and the ocean. That's not to say there's nothing to do: surfing and yoga sessions are both available for guests to join, and the surrounding area, with six state parks, is ripe for exploration.
